New to our Collection-part 1

As mentioned previously we have been given several artefacts and reproductions of the early 1800 period to augment the existing items at the Manor.

One of the early artefacts we have been given is a pistol. This is a percussion pistol circa 1830. There is a name plate on the side indicating it belonged to a soldier named Gooch. On a preliminary review the only person of that name from the period that arises is from the American forces.
