#### Stroll Into Summer with a Nelles Manor Neighbourhood Walk

Join us for the Museum's newest offering - a guided Nelles Manor Neighbourhood Walk. Tour the Nelles family's property as it would have been over 200 years ago. The Colonel Robert Nelles' property extended from Forty Mile Creek in the east, westward passed St Andrews Anglican Church along what is now Highway 8/Main Street West and from Lake Ontario to the Niagara Escarpment. You will see historic homes, the site of the Nelles mills, where 'our' militia were trained and learn some local history.

Walks may be scheduled during the day or evening, weekdays or weekends, April to October. Children must be accompanied by an adult.
